

COMPLAINT IN LIEU OF PREROGATIVE WRITS

The Plaintiff, by and through its undersigned attorney, hereby alleges as follows:

- 1. The Plaintiff, Residents Against Government Exploitation (hereinafter referred to as "RAGE"), is a duly formed non-profit corporation of New Jersey with members residing in the County of Monmouth.
- 2. The Defendant, Monmouth County, is a political subdivision of the State of New Jersey governed by a five member Board of Chosen Freeholders and charged with the responsibility of, among other things, administering a taxpayer funded Open Space Trust Fund.
- 3. The money in the Open Space Trust Fund is used to acquire lands for recreation, conservation and farmland preservation purposes.
- 4. On or about February 28, 2013, the Defendant, Monmouth County, through its Board of Chosen Freeholders, deliberated and voted on a resolution to disburse money from the

- Open Space Trust Fund to acquire a development easement upon real property (hereinafter referred to as the "Resolution").
- 5. The real property that was the subject of the Resolution was owned by Diamond Developers at Burke Farm, LLC and identified as Lots 8.01 and 9 of Block 69 on the official tax map of Manalapan Township, New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as "the Property").
- 6. During all relevant times referenced in this Complaint, Andrew Lucas (hereinafter "Lucas") owned and/or maintained a direct or indirect ownership interest in the Property by virtue of his direct or indirect ownership interest in Diamond Developers at Burke Farm, LLC.
- 7. The Resolution was approved after a deliberation of the Board of Chosen Freeholders and a final vote wherein three members voted in favor of adopting the Resolution and two members voted against it.
- One of the three members of the Board of Chosen Freeholders that voted in favor of adopting the Resolution was Freeholder, Lillian Burry.
- In October of 2011, Lucas, on information and belief, hosted a political fundraising event to raise campaign contributions and/or publicity for the benefit of, among others,
 Monmouth County Freeholder, Lillian Burry.
- 10. At the time of the above event, Freeholder Burry was running as a political candidate in the election for Monmouth County Freeholder that would take place on November 8, 2011.
- 11. Prior to voting on the Resolution, the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the Defendant,
 Monmouth County, was aware of a potential conflict of interest that existed in regards to

Freeholder Lillian Burry. By way of example, Freeholder Burry had a potential conflict of interest as follows

- a. As a member of the Board of Chosen Freeholders, Burry was obligated to determine whether the disbursement of money from the Open Space Trust Funds to acquire the development easement on the Property was in the best interests of the residents of Monmouth County. As such, Freeholder Burry may, therefore, be required to make a decision that would be detrimental to Lucas. However, it was also in the interests of Freeholder Burry that Monmouth County approved the purchase of the development easement on the Property since Lucas was directly or indirectly involved with significant efforts to help the election of Freeholders Burry.
- 12. Notwithstanding awareness of the potential conflict of interest above, Freeholder Burry deliberated and/or voted on adopting the Resolution.
- 13. Based on the above circumstances, Freeholder Burry had a potential interest and/or personal involvement in the outcome of the Resolution that was not shared in common with other members of the public.
- 14. As a direct and proximate result of Freeholder Burry deliberating and/or voting on the Resolution, it is invalid, unreasonable, arbitrary and capricious.

WHEREFORE, the Plaintiff, RAGE, demands judgment invalidating the February 28, 2013 Resolution by the Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders to purchase the development easement on the Property along with any other relief this Court deems just.
