Voting in the Voting Booth on Election Day

In order to vote for the Write-In Candidates on Election Day you must perform a write-in vote. The following steps show you how to perform a write-in vote.

When you arrive at the poll, you may ask the poll worker to show you how to do a write-in vote. Be sure to ask for a demonstration before you begin the voting process. Once the voting machine has been initialized, the poll worker will not enter voting booth due to privacy laws.

Write in Voting Instructions

- 1. Locate the line that says "FOR MAYOR".
- 2. Follow the row across to the column marked **Personal Choice** and press the square button marked **Write In** on the ballot. The box will flash with a green X and the keyboard will activate.



3. Use the keyboard to write "JOHN F COFFEY II"




Use the arrow keys to insert a space or correct any mistakes.

Once complete, press "Enter" on the keyboard.

Tip: Use the letter "I" key to type "II".

- 4. Locate the line that says "FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL (FULL TERM)".
- 5. Follow the row across to the column marked **Personal Choice** and press the square button marked **Write In** on the ballot. The box will flash with a green X and the keyboard will activate.



Tip: There are two personal choice lines in this row, you may use either line.

6. Use the keyboard to write "CULLIN WIBLE"



Use the arrow keys to insert a space or correct any mistakes. Once complete, press "Enter" on the keyboard. Complete your ballot. Press "CAST VOTE".
