IMPERSONATION - THEFT OF IDENTITY

FOURTH DEGREE CRIME

The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Monmouth, upon their oaths present that DWAYNE HORNER, on or about June 4, 2013, in or about the Township of Aberdeen and/or the Borough of Atlantic Highlands and/or the Borough of Fair Haven and/or the Township of Hazlet and/or the Borough of Highland and/or the Township of Holmdel and/or the Borough of Keansburg and/or the Borough of Keyport and/or the Borough of Little Silver and/or the Township of Marlboro and/or the Township of Middletown and/or the Borough of Monmouth Beach and/or the Borough of Oceanport and/or the Borough of Rumson and/or the Borough of Sea Bright and/or the Borough of Union Beach, County of Monmouth, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did commit the crime of Impersonation - Theft of Identity, pretends to be a representative of some person or organization and does an act in such a pretended capacity for the purpose of obtaining a benefit for himself or another or to injure or defraud another, contrary to the provisions of
